

(8) To the Right Reverend _____ Corporation Sole, the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, to be used by said Corporation Sole for carrying on the work of the Bureau of Catholic Charities of Los Angeles County, California.

(9) To the Los Angeles Orphan Asylum, now operating at 917 Boyle Avenue, Los Angeles, California, the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars.

(10) To the Reverend E. J. McCarthy, of St. Columban's Mission House, St. Columban, Nebraska, or to his successor in the work that he is now carrying on, in trust as trustee, the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, to be used by him for the purpose of advancing the interests of the Roman Catholic Church in China, no bond being required of said trustee.

(11) To my sister, Carrie E. Thompson, wife of John Thompson, now residing at New York City, the sum of Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars, should she survive me, but should she be dead then said Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars shall go to her son, John Miles Thompson, but should he be also dead at the time of my death, leaving living issue, then said Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars shall go, share and share alike, to his living issue, but should both my sister, Carrie E. Thompson, her son, John Miles Thompson, and all living issue of said John Miles Thompson, be dead, then said Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars shall be distributed as in my will hereinafter provided.

(12) To my sister, Ella C. Wells, the sum of Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars, should she survive me, but should she be dead at the time of my death, then said Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars shall go, share and share alike, to Francis Channing Wells and Utica Wells Beecham (Lady Beecham), or the survivor of either, but should they both be dead then said Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars shall remain in my estate to be distributed as hereinafter provided.

(13) To my nephew, Francis Channing Wells, should he survive me, my gold watch and chain, as a token of my esteem and regard for my said nephew. Should he not survive me, said watch and chain to remain a part of my estate.

After all of the legacies above mentioned have been paid in full, then should there still remain residue of my estate undisposed of, but not otherwise, of said undisposed residue I give, devise and bequeath:
